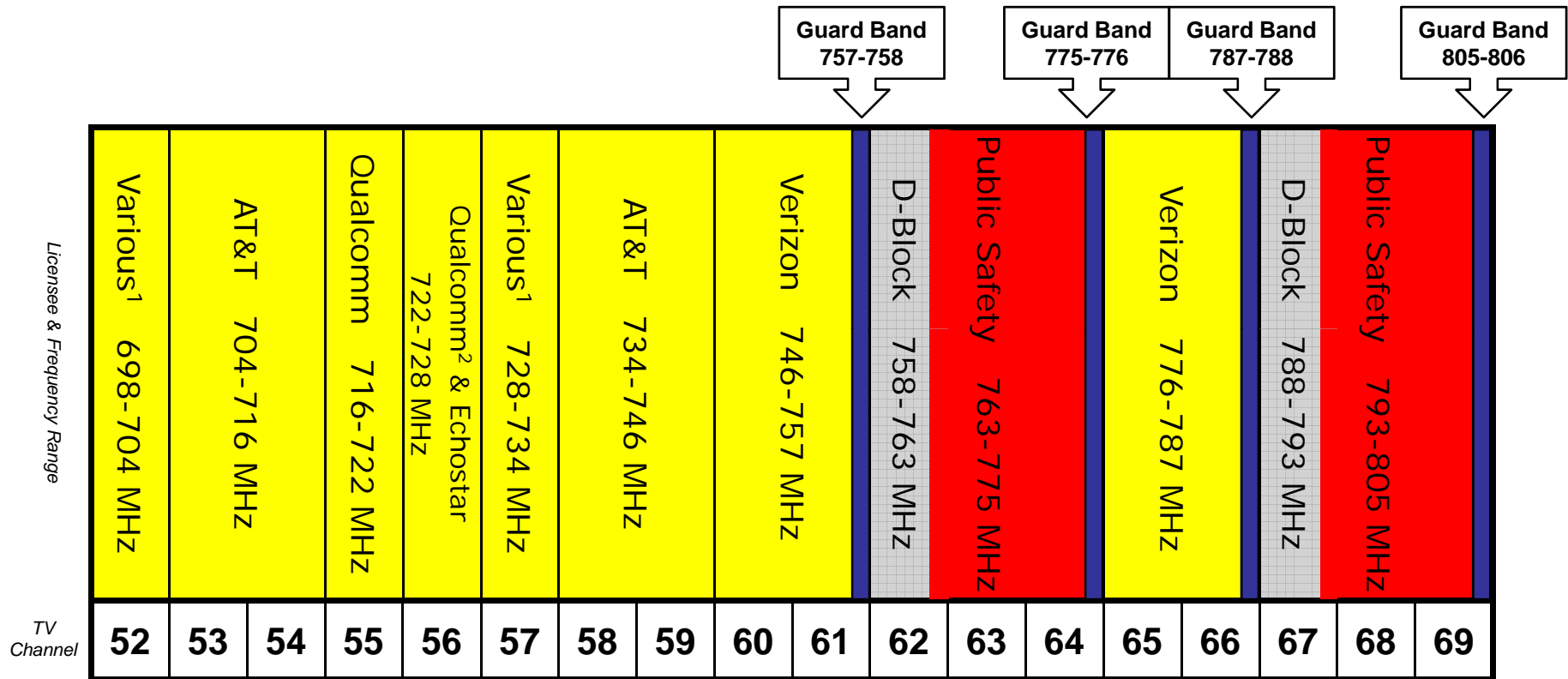


The U.S. 700 MHz Band (698-806 MHz)

Continued operation of these devices in the 700 MHz band is a violation of FCC rules, may interfere with commercial services and/or critical Public Safety communications, and may subject the user to FCC enforcement action.</p>
